

HOW-TO MAKE CARE KITS

Care kits contain essential items for people experiencing homelessness.



Fill a gallon-size plastic bag with travel or trial-sized of some or all of the following:

WHY PLASTIC?

Plastic keeps items dry and are reusable. <u>No</u> paper bags please.



1. HYGIENE ITEM(S)

<u>No</u> medicines or pills. <u>No</u> liquid hand sanitizers.

- Band aids (big ones to cover blisters)
- Deodorant
- Lip balm
- Lotion
- Wet wipes or bath wipes
- Nail clippers
- Cotton swabs
- Neosporin or antibiotic ointment

2. T-SHIRT OR SOCKS

New and large sizes are most needed.

3. WRAPPED SNACK

Must be easy to chew..

- Protein or granola bars
- Gum, mints or candy
- Peanut butter crackers

All items can be purchased from our <u>Amazon</u> wish list. Do not include any written materials.
